## Cervical Screening

### What is cervical screening and why is it important?

Cervical screening is a screening tool to check the cervix and screen for cervical cancer.

When completing cervical screening the nurse will use a speculum and cervical brush to take a sample from your cervix. This is firstly to check for the virus HPV and secondly review the cells taken, this is to make sure if there are any changes to these cells they are addressed quickly.

At Kildonan House we are completing a smear campaign and have a large number of Patients who do not attend DNA's. The Nurses who complete these Smears do this every day and will try to put you at ease as we understand the embarrassment, worry and anxiety women feel! We want every woman to feel comfortable and

secure at their appointment so please feel free to ask questions, to bring a person of support with you if that is what is needed

At the surgery we are actively contacting patients who are eligible For MMR vaccines. If you are worried your child has not had two MMR vaccines please do not hesitate to contact the surgery for advice. We have late night and early morning appointments for immunisations.
