COVID 19 autumn 2023 Booster

We have agreed to provide the COVID 19 booster from September.

Patients eligible are:

- Residents in a care home for older adults
- All adults aged 65 and over (born on or before 31st March 1959)
- Persons aged 6 months to 64 years in a clinical risk group as set out in the (green book)
- Frontline health and social care workers
- Persons aged 12 to 64 years who are household contacts of people with immunosuppression
- Persons aged 16 to 64 years who are carers.
- Pregnant women

Seasonal Flu vaccination

Patients eligible are:

- All adults aged 65 and over (born on or before 31st March 1959)
- Those aged 6 months to under 65 in clinical risk groups as set out in the (green book)
- Pregnant women
- All children aged 2- 3 years
- Primary school aged children (from reception to year 6)
- Those in long stay residential care homes
- Carers
- Close contact of immunocompromised individuals
- Front line health and social care workers.

Service Delivery

- Our clinics are in full swing and we are aiming to offer both vaccines at the same appointment for those patients who meet the criteria for both (this will be the vast majority).
- We started giving Covid and Flu vaccinations to our housebound patient from 14/09/2023.
- We have been sending out self-book links to Covid/flu appointments for those patients who are eligible.
- We have been contacting patients by land line if we don't have a mobile number listed for them. (if you have changed your number please inform us so we have your correct contact details).
- If you have not been contacted and believe that you are entitled to a vaccine, please contact the surgery on 01204 468161.
- We are holding the majority of the clinics at the Horwich RMI. Our latest clinic times are Monday – Thursday 10.00-18.00 and Saturday 9am-1pm and there are always walk in slots available on these same days too.
